MEDIA ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

The Antalya Diplomacy Forum 2026 (ADF2026) will be held as the Forum's fifth event on 17-19 April 2026 with the theme "Mapping Tomorrow, Managing Uncertainties" and will host guests from all over the world.



Forum Venue and Information

- The Forum will be held at the NEST Convention Center (<https://www.nestconventioncenter.com/EN>) Antalya / Belek.
- The language of the Forum will be English.

- Simultaneous interpretation will be available in Turkish and English in all sessions. Necessary set up for simultaneous interpretation in French, Spanish, Arabic and Russian will also be available in the opening session, and when needed in other sessions.
- Media members who will follow the Forum are expected to arrive in Antalya on Thursday, 16 April 2026. The forum will end at noon on Sunday, 19 April 2026.
- A Media Centre will be available for members of the media at the NEST Convention Center.



Press Accreditation

- Accreditation rules for the Forum have been announced by the Directorate of Communications of the Presidency of the Republic of Türkiye.

- Information and documents required for **accreditation application** are specified in the aforementioned announcement. Application deadline is **31 March 2026 (before 13.00 CET)**.
- National and international media members are expected to submit their accreditation applications by uploading the requested documents via <http://akreditasyon.iletisim.gov.tr> internet address of the Directorate of Communications of the Presidency of the Republic of Türkiye.
- Kindly be advised that once accreditation is completed, media members must also register to ADF2026.
- Following the registration process, media members will receive a confirmation e-mail from the Directorate of Communications.

- Media members without online registration **will not be allowed** access to the Forum area.
- Yellow Press Badges can be collected from the Press Desk at the NEST Convention Center as of **16 April 2026**.

Official Press

- Official press members (official photographer and/or official cameraman) who are part of official delegations are not subject to accreditation procedure.
- Official delegations should send their list of participants, including official press members, to registration@antalyadf.org and receive a password and a link for online registration to ADF2026.
- Online registration must be completed before **6 April 2026**. Registration requests will not be processed after this deadline.
- Official press members will be given a Yellow Badge with a Black Stripe.
- Badges will be distributed in Antalya by the ADF Secretariat and Turkish liaison officers for official delegations.

Before Arrival

- ADF notices and updates will be posted on the “Antalya Diplomacy Forum” mobile application which can be downloaded via: Google Play and App Store for IOS and Android systems.

Broadcast:

- Welcoming, the opening ceremony and all panels will be broadcast live by Turkish public broadcaster TRT via a free “pool” system.
- Live streams can be watched on the ADF website and the ADF mobile application.
- Pool frequency and a link for each panel hall will be posted on the ADF website as well as the ADF application.

Travel and Accommodation

- Media members are kindly expected to cover **their own international/domestic travel costs** to/from Antalya as well as **their accommodation expenses**.
- Dobedan Hotel (www.dobedanhotels.com) is designated for journalists who will follow ADF2026.
- A discounted price has been arranged with the aforementioned hotel for members of the media. The code to be submitted during reservation for discounted rate is “ADF2026”.

Shuttle

- Shuttle services will be provided between the Airport and the designated hotels, also between hotels and the Nest Convention Center.

- No private vehicles will have access to the Forum area except those assigned to official delegations.

Health

- Medical assistance teams will be present at the Forum venue.

- Media members requiring a visa before travelling to Türkiye are kindly advised to initiate their applications timely at the Turkish diplomatic missions abroad.

- Participants are kindly advised to have a **travel document/passport valid for at least 6 months** as of the date of their arrival in Türkiye.
- Prayer rooms will be available in the Forum area.

- **Time zone:** Türkiye is +03:00 hours ahead of GMT.
